





<u>Measurement:</u> All horses must be measured to receive an exhibitor number.

Measurement times as follows: (Other times may be arranged by contacting the Show Manager in ADVANCE

Tuesday: 3:00pm - 7:00pm Friday: 4:00pm - 5:00pm Show Days: 7:00am - 7:30am

Health Requirements: Out of state origin: A negative coggins test for EIA dated within 12 months of the show and a veterinarian health certificate dated within 30 days of the show. Management reserves the right to have seeming sick horses examined by a veterinarian and/or removed from the fairgrounds at the owner's expense.

Veterinarian: On call - posted in the show office.

<u>Liberty Classes:</u> Liberty tapes must be turned into the show office at least 1/2 hour prior to beginning of class. Tapes must be clearly marked with exhibitor number and name and be cued to go.

Gate Call: The two minute gate call will be strictly enforced. The two minutes begins when the class is called and the first horse enters the ring. If a tack change is needed, notification must be given to the gate person to avoid being disqualified from the class. NO refunds will be given for missed classes. Tack Changes will only be given an additional 5 minutes, two of which will be the "two minute gate call".

Feed & Bedding: May be purchased from the fairgrounds during normal business hours. Bedding may be pre-purchased on the entry form. After that all purchases must be made through the Stanley Park Facility Office and must be paid before delivery can be made.




